Register of Members' Interests

Disclosable Pecuniary Interests

Pursuant to the Localism Act 2011 and the relevant Authorities
(Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012

Under the above legislation Councillors are required within 28 days of becoming a Member to register their disclosable pecuniary interests in the authority's register by providing written notification to the Monitoring Officer. This form should also be reviewed regularly.

Failure to register your disclosable pecuniary interests within 28 days of becoming a Member or declaring a pecuniary interest at a meeting is a criminal offence and could result in a fine of up to £5000 or disqualification up to 5 years.
